Nariño, located in the southern Colombia, is known for its unique handicrafts using natural resin, Barniz de Pasto, also known as mopa-mopa. Ms. Apráez is creating jewelry works applying this technique, which has been handed down by indigenous people since ancient times.

In this seminar, she will talk on a wide range of her past and recent works, including the process of making mopa-mopa, as well as her award-winning pieces. The Embassy of Colombia will also take this opportunity to introduce the charm of their country.
